Programme Highlights

Solid waste management is fundamental to the sustainable development of an international city. According to the Government about the consultation outcome, about 60% of the respondents supported within the community for the introduction of quantity-based Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) charging. Based on this outcome, the Government affirms that a quantity-based MSW charging system should be the approach in pursuing the initiative. The Council for Sustainable Development (SDC) accepted the invitation by the Environment Bureau to conduct a second-stage public engagement process this year to gauge the community's views and foster in-depth, open and cross sector discussion on the proposed implementation details of the charging scheme. Through this seminar, the speaker will present the key issues and considerations related to implementing MSW charging in Hong Kong.
